Subject: Conflict minerals — Dodd-Frank Act Section 1502; SEC Rule 13p-1

To Whom It May Concern:

This letter responds to inquiries as to whether products manufactured and supplied by Superflex Ltd. contain conflict minerals as defined in Section 1502 of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act and the implementing rules of the U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission — cassiterite (tin), columbite-tantalite (tantalum), wolframite (tungsten) and gold, or their derivatives ("3TG") — originating in the Democratic Republic of the Congo or an adjoining country (the "Covered Countries").

It is the policy of Superflex Ltd. not to knowingly purchase or use, in any of its products, conflict minerals that directly or indirectly finance or benefit armed groups in the Covered Countries, and to expect the same of our suppliers.

Superflex Ltd. is not an issuer subject to SEC reporting and does not source 3TG minerals directly. Our products are polymer articles — PVC, nylon and polyethylene conduit, tubing, hose and fittings, and die-cast aluminum and zinc weatherproof enclosures — and do not contain gold, tantalum or tungsten. The only 3TG-derived material necessary to the production or functionality of our products is tin, which is present in the organotin heat stabilizers used in PVC compounds. Based on the responses received to our reasonable country-of-origin inquiries of the suppliers of these compounds, it is our understanding and belief that the tin they contain does not originate in the Covered Countries, and that our products are therefore "DRC conflict-free" as that term is used in the SEC rule.

We will continue to make reasonable inquiry of our suppliers and will advise customers should this information change. We are pleased to complete a customer's Conflict Minerals Reporting Template (CMRT) on request.

This information is provided in good faith and is accurate to the best of our knowledge as of the date above. It is based on our own formulations and on written declarations from our raw-material suppliers, is subject to change as regulations and supplier data are updated, and is offered to assist the recipient's own compliance review rather than as a warranty. Please contact Superflex Ltd. for a statement covering specific part numbers or a later revision of the regulation.
